Day of Test Entries will run after the pre-entered dogs.

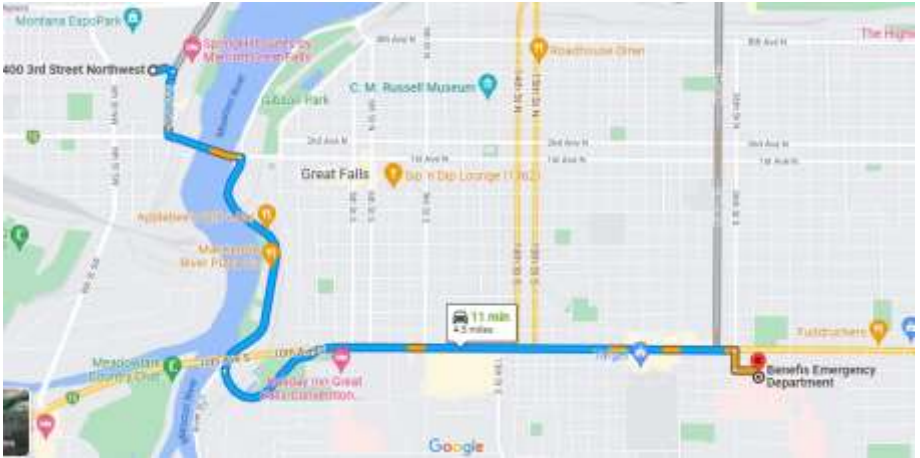
Your dog will be allowed 3 attempts to chase the lure before you will be asked to leave the test.

DIRECTIONS TO THE EVENT SITE

Montana Expo Park 400 3rd St NW, Great Falls, MT 59404

Directions from Interstate 15 North, take Exit 280 (Central Ave West). Travel east to 6th St SW. Turn left at light, heading north approx. ½ mile. Turn right at Entrance into MT EXPO PARK west gate.

Directions from Interstate 15 South, take Exit 280 (Central Ave West). Travel east to 6th St SW. Turn left at light, heading north approx. ½ mile. Turn right at Entrance into MT EXPO PARK west gate.

Directions from Highway 89 South -Follow 10th Ave South approximately 6 ½ mi. Turn right on 6th St. SW. Turn right at Entrance into MT EXPO PARK west gate.

Directions from Highway 89 North- Turn right on NW Bypass. Go to next traffic light (1/2 mile) & turn left onto 6th St NW. Go approximately 2 miles & turn at Entrance into MT EXPO PARK West.



Attention Exhibitors: There will be other events scheduled at the Fairgrounds on same dates as our FastCat Events. In order to safely and efficiently park, we ask that you use **ONLY** the entrance shown on this map.

Field, Facility. Fencing:

- Mowed grass field, mostly flat.
- The test run lane is completely fenced for safety.
- Bathroom facilities are available in nearby buildings.
- Dogs not running their event must be leashed or confined to a crate.
- Please keep the grounds and buildings clean by picking up after yourself and your dog. Dispose of poop bags in the trash containers provided.

Timing:

Electronic Timers will be used for this event. In the event of a malfunction of the timing equipment or inclement weather, 2 stop watches may be substituted for timing.

Inspection:

All dogs will be inspected for soundness and measured, if needed, prior to running each test. All bitches will be checked by the owner for being in season prior to running each event. Bring your own tissues. Any entry found during inspection to be unfit to complete, lame, or bitches in season shall be barred from competition and entry fees shall be refunded.

Runs:

You are responsible for providing a releaser and a catcher for your dog. None will be available from the Electric City Kennel Club or the event committee.

ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNERS SOLE RISK
NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

1. Coursing Ability & Fast CAT tests are open to all dogs **12 months of age or older** that are individually registered with AKC, recognized foreign registries or have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS). Open to all sighthounds as well as those with breed disqualifications.
2. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signature, and the Agreement found on the Official AKC Entry Form in this premium.
3. **REFUNDS:** Bitches in season and lame dogs will be refused entry and, if presented at inspection, will be refunded entry less the AKC recording fee. Refunds or other absences or withdrawals made after the event entry closing date will not be made.
4. Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded less the AKC recording fee.
5. Racing muzzles are allowed. The dog must wear a collar to run. Tie up any tags dangling. No pinch collars and no electronic training collars or devices are allowed.
6. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, and communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
7. The HUNTMASER is responsible for field safety and therefore s/he is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, s/he has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
8. Any decisions made by the Event officials regarding the performance of an entered dog shall be final. Full discretionary power is given to the Event officials to withhold any and all qualifications for lack of merit. The Event officials are responsible for ensuring compliance with the AKC Regulations on the field.
9. Entry fees will not be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.
10. Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC or ECKC trial volunteers or any dog(s) or other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.
11. There will be a minimum of \$25 returned check charge.
12. ECKC reserves the right to alter the course due to field and/or weather conditions on the day of the test. The entire course and run-out area will be fenced. Areas outside of the course are not fenced. Exhibitors must contain and control their dogs at all times.
13. Children **MUST** be under control of their parents or guardians at all times.
14. Any dog that eliminates on the course or in the run-out area will receive a non-qualifying (NQ) score.
15. Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, and Handler of the dog running in the course in progress will be permitted near the lure machine.
16. The Club, ECKC, its agents, members, representatives, and volunteers assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage, illness or injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event. By entering this event, you agree to this provision.
17. **Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. **There will be an outside designated area where dogs are allowed to relieve themselves.** Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the trial grounds.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any

claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.
